The complete reference of the forum where Item 1997 was published is: *Is America a Civilization?* NO: Arnold Toynbee, Hans K. Galinski; YES: Max Lerner, Willard Thorp. *Comments from America*: David M. Potter, Henry Beston, John Hague; *Comments from Abroad*: Marcus Cunliffe, George Shepperson, Yves Couderc, John McCormick, in «Shenandoah. The Washington and Lee University Review», X, 1, Autumn, 1958, pp. 3-45. The forum was introduced by Marshall Fish, according to whom «The theme came from conversations with Professor Arnold Toynbee during his visiting lectureship at Washington and Lee in the spring term of 1958. Since Max Lerner's thousand-page opus, *America as a Civilization*, had just appeared, he was the obvious person to comment on Dr. Toynbee's view. The two essays were provocative enough to draw further observations from distinguished scholars and writers in the area of American thought; by printing a dozen of these, we have attempted to turn what started out as a debate into a symposium» (ivi, pp. 3-4).
