The original article was subdivided in an introductory section and three further paragraphs – *A Mosque in Aleppo, Economic Development, Pan-Arabism*.

It was introduced by the English newspaper as follows: «Professor Toynbee is contributing a series of articles to the "Manchester Guardian" while travelling to China and Japan by way of the Near and Middle East. He describes in the following article the repercussions of the Palestinian troubles as he noted them in Syrian and Iraq».
