412) Arnold J. Toynbee, *Polygamy "Old-Fashioned"*, in *Vanishing Harems. Polygamy Dying Out in Turkey. Women's Bid for Freedom. Monogamy To Be Compulsory*, «Westminster Gazette», Wednesday, January 2, 1924, p. 1. Text below.

«Polygamy in Turkey to-day is only practiced by the very wealthy or old-fashioned», declared Mr. Arnold J. Toynbee, the lecturer and authority on Turkey and the Near East. «The general thing is to have only one wife.

Enlightened Turks are keen on following Western ideas, and therefore monogamy is practiced among them. In this respect institutions like the American College for Girls, in Constantinople, have greatly helped to imbue the modern Turkish woman with new ideas. When she marries she will not accept the old conditions».
