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
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Surrealism and Creative Dissociation: The Dalì "case"



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Surrealism is a pure psychic automatism, by which one proposes to express, either verbally, in writing, or by any other manner, the real functioning of thought. 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

2h30m after: focus on the outline, marked contour, changing of reality colours. Salvador Dalì. *Alice in Wonderland* (series, 1965-1969)

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2h32m after: loss of hand perception, outline loss of drawing.

2h45m after: uncontrolled trembling, delirium, the artist utters incoherent phrases. Salvador Dalì. *Alice in Wonderland* (series, 1965-1969)

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4h25m after: stupefaction, numbness, then the artist starts again to draw running into the lab.


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

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8h after: the artist returns to a normal state, occasional uncontrolled face distortions. Surrealism and Creative Dissociation: The Dalì "case"








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
