Additions, Correction and Integrations to Part I, Works by Arnold J. Toynbee

228) Item 1311 – Arnold J. Toynbee, *The Issues in British Foreign Policy*, I., Address given at Chatham House on March 10th, 1938, in «International Affairs», XVII, 3, May-Jun. 1938, pp. 307-337 – was also extensively reported in «The Left Forum», June-September 1939, pp. 170 *et seq.*

229) Significant portions of Item 1311 were quoted in Lord Astor, *National Service. A Normal Democratic Principle. Defence of a Great Empire*, in «The Times», March 24, 1939, p. 15. Letter to the Editor. Dated March 23.

230) S. Fiona Morton erroneously dated Toynbee's address «March 19», *after* Germany's occupation and annexation of Austria, which occurred between the 11th and the 13th of March. Actually, the version of the paper published in «International Affairs» *had to be brought to date* in order to take into account that momentous event.

231) In the discussion that followed Toynbee's address took part Henry Wickham Steed, Nigel Walter Law, Robert W. Seton Watson, W.J. Rose, J. Silkin, J.C. French as well as an anonymous «Member» of the Royal Institute of International Affairs (Toynbee's reply at p. 337).
