«Chen Hua» was published in Shanghai from 1916 to 1918 by Theodore Leslie, the (former?) business manager of the Shanghai branch of the Christian Literature Society for China who in 1917 took over the Chinese Agency of the Oxford University Press, started in 1913. No. 327 was a reprint of Item 966 (Arnold J. Toynbee, *«The Murderous Tyranny of the Turks»*, with a Preface by Viscount Bryce, London, Hodder and Stoughton, 1917). No. 328 was a reprint of James Bryce's introductory Statement and the first four chapters of Item 947 (Arnold J. Toynbee, *The Belgian Deportations*, with a Statement by Viscount Bryce,

London, T. Fisher Unwin, 1917).
