Europe's Lost Ascendancy. National Units Too Small. United States the Future Model, in «The Manchester Guardian», Thursday, October 28, 1926, p. 4. A newspaper account of a lecture on *The Dwarfing of Europe* given by Toynbee on October 27 at Kingsway Hall, London, with Hugh Dalton in the chair. The second of a series of six lectures organized by the Fabian Society, dealing with «dangers and possibilities» inherent in «the shrinking of the world» from an internationalist perspective, Toynbee's lecture formed the basis of the homonymous chapter 6 in Item 1362 (see A.J. Toynbee, *Acknowledgments*, in *Civilization on Trial*, London, Oxford University Press, 1948, p. VI, and *The Dwarfing of Europe*, *ibid.*, pp. 97-125). The Fabian Society also published a syllabus of the series (*The Shrinking World, Dangers and Possibilities*, A course of six lectures to be given at Kingsway Hall on Wednesdays at 8.30 p.m., beginning 20th October, 1926, London, Standring, 1926, I. *The Control of World Finance*, by William Graham; II. *The Dwarfing of Europe*, by Arnold J. Toynbee; III. *The Danger of Creed Wars*, by Bertrand Russell; IV. *Voluntary Internationalism*, by Sidney Webb; V. *The Conflict of Race and Colour*, by S.K. Ratcliffe; VI. *Cultural Internationalism*, by Bernard Shaw).
